The chart above, courtesy of finviz.com, shows the year-to-date (September 30, 2020) price change in every stock in the S&P 500 Index. The size of the rectangle is based on the value of the company's shares. The index is dominated by a few technology-related giants. You can also see how the surge (bubble?) in Apple, Amazon and Microsoft shares masks weaker performance elsewhere.
